THE DEADLINE HAS BEEN EXTENDED FOR MEIJER MEMBERS TO COMPLETE THEIR HEALTH SCREENING

The deadline has been extended to Monday, April 30 for members at Meijer to complete their health screening for the *Healthy at Meijer* program. Members can complete their health screenings by printing the BiolQ Physician Results Form from the Jiff app or website at app.jiff.com, and then scheduling an appointment with their primary care physician to have the form completed prior to the deadline. Members may also visit any Meijer pharmacy before 4:00 p.m. for a screening.



The benefits of completing the screening and participating in the program include discounts on health insurance premiums, increased company contributions to Health Savings Accounts (HSA) or Personal Health Banks (PHB), and access to new programs, tools and resources to help improve and maintain health.

Insurance costs shown on the Meijer Rewards site already reflect the discounted premiums. Members at Meijer who do not complete the health screening by the new April 30 deadline will be charged a higher insurance premium than is listed on the website.
