## DON'T FORGET TO VOTE ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8

The 2022 general election will take place on Tuesday, November 8. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Be sure to bring your ID to the polls as Michigan law requires a photo ID in order to vote. Voters who do not bring a picture ID can vote by signing an affidavit.

Voters who cannot make it to their polling location on election day may request an absentee ballot. Requests must be made by mail or submitted online by November 4 at 5:00 p.m. or in-person at your city or township clerk no later than November 7 at 4:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots must be returned by mail or received in-person at your city or township clerk no later than 8:00 p.m. local time on November 8.

"Aside from running for office, voting is the most significant means that citizens have to influence their government to work for them," John Cakmakci, UFCW 951 president said. "By casting your ballot for candidates that share your values, you are making your voice heard."

The deadline to register to vote by mail or online is Monday, October 24. Early voting began on September 29 and will run through November 7.
