TOP RATE MEMBERS AT MEIJER TO RECEIVE WAGE INCREASES IN AUGUST

The new top rates at Meijer will become effective in August. Members at Meijer who are at top rate in an eligible job classification and who have worked the required amount of hours are set to receive a union-negotiated wage increase on August 19, 2018. Eligible top rate team members who haven't met the hourly requirement by August 19 will advance to the new top rate in the pay period after reaching the required number of hours.

Additionally, the second Top Rate Adjustment (TRA) payout for 2018 will occur by mid-September for members at top rate in the eligible classifications.

THERE ARE STILL OPPORTUNITIES TO WIN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS IN 2018
