ENROLLMENT FOR 2020 HEALTHCARE BENEFITS BEGINS SOON

Open enrollment for many UFCW 951 members will begin in the coming weeks. Eligible members at Meijer and Kroger who intend to sign up for healthcare benefits in 2020 should make note of the dates below.

Kroger Members: The 2020 open enrollment period for eligible Heartland Health and Wellness Fund participants is November 11, 2019 through December 8, 2019. Look for your 2020 enrollment packet in your mailbox in early November.

MEMBERS MAY NOW APPLY FOR 2020 FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS AND REIMBURSEMENTS

Applications for the 2020 Foundation scholarships and reimbursements are now available. The UFCW 951 Foundation will award \$73,000 in scholarships and reimbursements in 2020! Winners will be selected in January, April, July and October, except for the college scholarships which will be awarded in June.

CHILD CARE SCHOLARSHIPS - TWELVE \$750 AWARDS

Helps members with the cost of child care expenses.



FIFTEEN \$2,000 AWARDS - COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Assists with tuition at a college, university or trade school.

EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS - TWENTY \$500 AWARDS

Reimburses members for education related expenses.



TWENTY \$100 AWARDS - FAMILY ENRICHMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Reimburses expenses for a child's participation in extracurricular activities.

MEDICAL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM - FORTY \$250 AWARDS

Assists members with eligible medical expenses and weekly copays.



EIGHTY \$150 AWARDS - UTILITY REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

Reimburses members for their propane, natural gas, electricity and water bills.
