HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR THE NOVEMBER PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

Concerns over the Coronavirus pandemic continue to be on the minds of many Americans. The result of this has been an increased interest in voting by mail as a safer alternative to voting in-person in this November's presidential election.

In Michigan, any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot for any reason. You can request an absentee ballot by completing the online application at www.michigan.gov/vote or by submitting an application, letter, or postcard requesting an absentee ballot to your local clerk. Requests for absent voter ballots may be returned by hand, via postal mail, fax or email, as long as a signature is visible.

After receiving your absentee ballot, you have until 8 p.m. on Election Day to complete the ballot and return it to the clerk's office. Your ballot will not be counted unless your signature is on the return envelope and matches your signature on file. Only you, a family member or other person residing in your household, a mail carrier, or an election official is authorized to deliver your signed absent voter ballot to your clerk's office.
